Agreement Signed Between Atinar Properties and the Forest City Velodrome Association

An agreement has been reached between **Atinar Properties** and the **Forest City Velodrome Association** to construct and operate an indoor portable velodrome and multiuse sports facility in the old Icehouse in the south end of London, Ontario.

Once completed, this will be the first new velodrome in Ontario in 25 years.

The construction of the velodrome will begin immediately, with a scheduled completion date in mid- to late March 2005. The track will be 142 metres, ideal for instruction, training, and racing. A more in-depth program schedule will follow in the coming weeks.

Among the programs that will be available at the velodrome are children's safety riding skills for kids 4-10 years old; Youth Future Champions programs for ages 11-16 years; disabled athlete's programs geared to the Para-Olympic games; youth and adult recreational programs to promote a healthier lifestyle in the community; and the Elite Racing program to build athletic performance for national and international competition.

The other activities to be in place at the building in the coming months include a running track around the top of the seating area; courts on the infield for other sports or groups to use during the week; and a weight room, whirlpool and sauna.

Atinar Properties and the Forest City Velodrome Association look forward to producing some of Canada's top Olympic & Para-Olympic athletes in the years to come.
